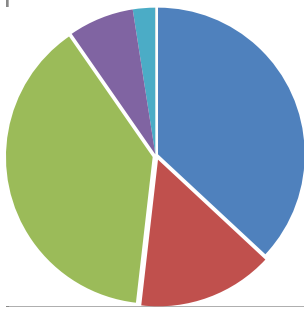
About Communities In Schools

Is Communities In Schools a Good Investment?

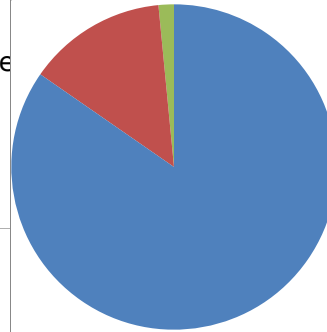
